



# **Youth Guarantee Application Guide 2012**

## **Purpose**

CPIT is offering Youth Guarantee places for students who meet the Youth Guarantee (YG) criteria and who wish to study a Youth Guarantee eligible programme at CPIT. YG students do not pay any fees for their study.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria for Youth Guarantee (as below).

## **Who can apply**

Applicants must:

- be 16 or 17 years of age and not turn 18 within three months of starting the programme
- be a New Zealand citizen or have New Zealand permanent residency
- meet the entry requirements and be accepted onto one of the eligible CPIT YG programmes.

## **Conditions**

- YG students are exempt from student fees for only one year and there is an expectation that you will finish your programme within a year of enrolling.
- Students are not eligible for loans of any kind from StudyLink.
- Applicants must be willing to have their progress monitored and take part in a programme of Learning Support.

## **Selection Criteria**

The criteria of selection will be based on:

- demonstration of a genuine desire to succeed in your chosen field of study and aspirations for employment once qualified
- demonstration of aptitude for the selected programme
- students whose pathway choices best match the availability in the programmes.

## **Selection Process**

- Submit a completed application form to CPIT.
- Applicants who meet the criteria will be accepted on a 'first in first served' basis
- Applicants may be required to attend an interview and undertake an assessment.
